Wednesday Program

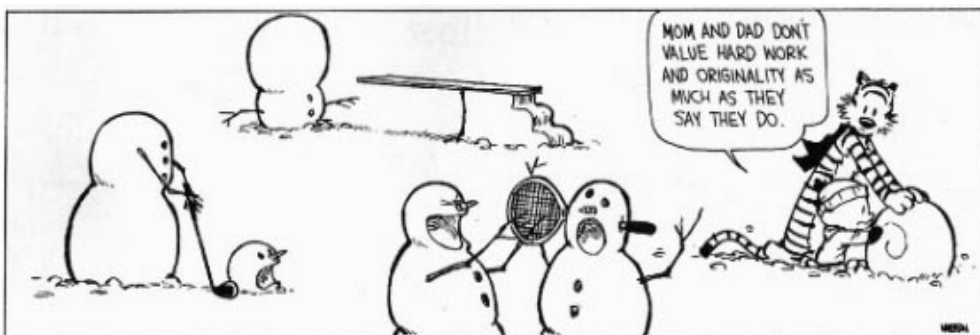
