## Sign Up For April Mystery Trip

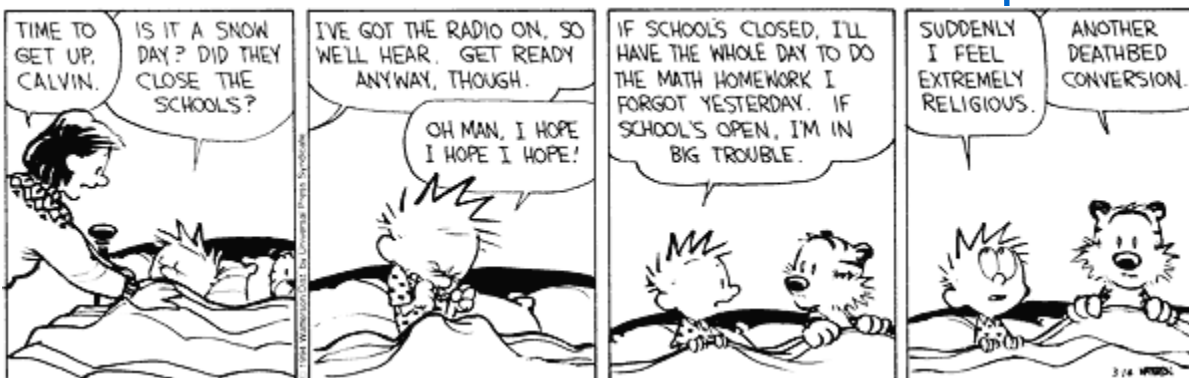
